

## HYMNS TODAY

### *FATHER IN WHOM WE LIVE*

Written by Charles Wesley, brother of John (founder of Methodism), was educated at Christ Church, Oxford University. Ordained in 1735, became influenced by the Moravians, he began a stream of hymn writing. He preached enthusiastically out of doors and faced the dangers thereof of rowdies and cat-calling. It is said that he wrote 6,500 hymns.

### *BLEST ARE THE PURE IN HEART*

This hymn was written by the Divine John Keble and William John Hall. 'Pure in heart' refers to those who are sincere and single-minded in their desire to love and serve God. Keble was educated at Corpus Christi, Oxford University and was a brilliant student. In 1831 he became Professor of Poetry and in 1833 began the Oxford Movement.

### *TAKE MY LIFE AND LET IT BE*

Frances Ridley Havergal wrote this when staying in a home where she had been used to leader the two daughters of the house to Christ. 'It was nearly midnight. I was too happy to sleep, and spent most of the night in praise and renewal of my own consecration. These little couplets formed themselves and chimed in my heart one after another till they finished with "ever, only, all for Thee".'

### *SAVIOUR, AGAIN TO THY DEAR NAME WE RAISE*

This hymn by John Ellerton won a place for itself among the great English evening hymns. Born in London, educated on the Isle of Man and Trinity, Cambridge University. He was ordained an Anglican minister. He wrote or translated 80 or so hymns. He refused any royalty for them saying they were inspired by God. During his last hours he continually sang or repeated hymns.
