Dr. Beals was ordained in 1998 by Sunrise Baptist Church, London, ON, as part of the Canadian Baptists of Ontario and Quebec, and in 2007 transferred to the Canadian Baptists of Atlantic Canada. In May 2016, Dr. Beals graduated with a Doctor of Ministry degree from Acadia University. Her thesis entitled, "The Art of Belonging: Clergy Formation



and Wellness" explored burnout, well-being, and resilience among Canadian Baptist clergy in Atlantic Canada. She is also a spiritual director 2019), she completed her training with CenterQuest School of Spiritual Direction, California, USA.
